About our elder, Victor Schwartz

Victor Schwartz came to Shatford for the 75th anniversary and taught us all about his life at Shatford years ago. He told us about the many things that have changed since then, including interesting facts and real-life things that changed. When he was at Shatford, he played a game called Marbles, where you threw the marbles you brought from home into a hole you would make with your heel in the dirt. If you got it in, you got everyone else's marbles. That was a big thing because you could trade the marbles for these big ones, they were about the size of a toonie, and were called a doughboy. The doughboys were a good thing. Once he traded a doughboy for 5 marbles! There were also these black ones called cat eyes, because they were black and had a yellow middle. Not everything was good about Shatford all those years ago. This next thing was something you would be glad to get rid of. He, and every other person in the school, had to take Cod-Liver oil pills. Judy was in the last grade 12 class in Shatford Memorial Elementary School. When Judy was in school there was a hockey team. On the hockey jersey it said S.M.E. Her motto is "Responsibility, courtesy, respect" (R.C.R.) And she showed all of that. We hope that she thinks we did all of that, too! Judy is one of the nicest people we know. Whenever we see her on the road, she is just kind and nice. Judy was in the Masthead newspaper because she was the May Queen! Fun fact: Xander's house used to be a school and she used to go there. It was called Hubbards School. Judy used to live in Ocean's house. She said that when she lived in that house there was no inside bathroom so they had to use an outside toilet. We bet in the wintertime their bums would get pretty cold. When Judy was in school at Shatford, the office that Ms. Tanya works in was the grade 12 classroom! That is what Ms. Hopkins told us to imagine: a whole grade 12 classroom in that small space! That's crazy! How many kids do you think were in that class? They didn't have the wall when Judy was in grade 12. Judy really was an important part of the community and the history of the school!

About our Elder, Anne Hare

Anne Hare is Bonnie and Ebbs's Grandma, and the daughter of Albert and Esther Dorey. She is very kind and nice. She came to our school about a week ago and told us what Shatford Memorial School was like when she came here. She told us that there used to be a Hubbards hockey team and they played at the Boutilliers Point hockey rink, and sometimes the girls would play broomball. They didn't have bathrooms inside, so they had outhouses with two toilets beside each other with no running water. Anne Hare can draw a really good turkey; she showed us in her 'normal' drawing book. 'Normal' meaning the drawing book most people had. She also said there used to be an ice cream shop in Hubbards at the end of Row Boat Row. In 1914 her grandfather Richmond Dorey built it and Anne's grandmother used the building as an ice cream shop. They would get the cream from a dairy farm that was where the Shore Club is now. The cream was put in a tin can the into a wood ice cream maker, they put layers of ice and salt around the can until it froze They made homemade ice and stored the ice in sawdust in a barn.

About our elder, John Stone

On April 24 John Stone came to share about his life at Shatford when he was a kid. John Stone is Ms. Stone's dad, he is very kind, funny and has a lovely personality. He also is a very good storyteller, here are some of his stories. He told us a story about a time when he was little and he was walking on the beach, he found a wallet that was a sailor's. It had 80 dollars in it (which was a lot of money at the time), he took that wallet and hid it in the crawl space under his house. The third day he had it, his father asked him "what was so cool under the house." He said "nothing." His father asked him again and he said he found a wallet on the beach that had 80 dollars in it. His father checked the ID and contacted the sailor that it had belonged to. When the sailor came to get it, he said it was probably from when he was swimming and it fell out. After the sailor offered a reward and the dad said that John did not deserve it but the sailor gave his dad 10 bucks and gave John half of it. He told us that there used to be a wooden school where Xander's house is on Schwartz Road. Then after a very long time at that school, they started to make a new school which is Shatford Memorial Elementary school. John Stone started to go to school there and most of his stories are from this school. He said that when the king died and his daughter Queen Elizabeth became queen the lyrics of the song changed to 'God save our grateful Queen' from 'God save the King' which was kind of a big deal at the time. When he was little, he used to play in dumps a lot and he played in this widow's aunt Minnie's dump who really did not like it when he did, but he and his friends would keep on doing it. One day they were digging and John found two unbroken wine glasses which was at the very bottom of the dump (which he may still have). He also found a purse which of course



John opened and found 2 stamps from Canada and 1 stamp from Denmark. He couldn't go and ask where the widow got the stamp cause how did a stamp from Denmark come this far and he wasn't allowed to be in her dump so he took the purse and showed it to his mom. One day he was coming home from school and his buddy told him the Bluenose 2 was in the cove and would be going in the morning. He looked out his window (he could see the cove from there) and saw the ship and thought there's no way that ship is going because there was no wind. The ship still went out because the Bluenose 2 caught a higher wind by getting out of the cove using only the top sail which John thought was very cool.

Avah

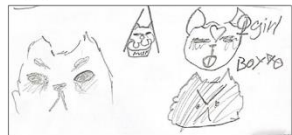
Corgis are a type of dog.

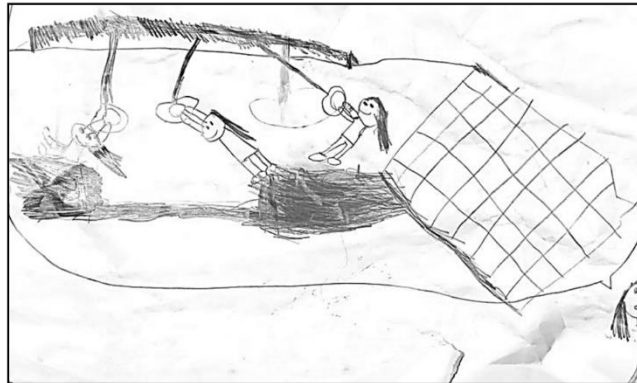

Flourless Chocolate Chip Peanut Butter Cookies

Robin

Prep: 10 min, Bake: 8-10 min, Total: 18 min, Yield 18 cookies

Ingredients:

- 1 cup smooth peanut butter (269g)
- ¾ cups packed brown sugar (161 g)
- ½ tsp baking soda
- Pinch of salt
- 1 large egg
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- ½ cup chocolate chips or mini chips (85g)

Instructions:

1. Preheat oven to 350°F
2. Beat the peanut butter, sugar, baking soda, and salt at medium speed on your mixer until well combined
3. Add egg & vanilla. Blend on low medium until incorporated
4. Stir in the chocolate chips
5. Scoop the dough onto a parchment-lined baking sheet (a table spoon is best) and push slightly to flatten the top of the dough
6. Bake the cookies for 8-10 min. Remove from the oven and cool on the pan. The tops should be slightly crinkled and you will want to pull them out before they begin to brown on the edges.

Tips from our bakers:

This recipe does not work as well with natural peanut butter as with standard store-bought peanut butter. The result is a drier, crumblier cookie. This recipe is gluten free but if you want it to be dairy free use dairy free chocolate chips.

Bush Babies

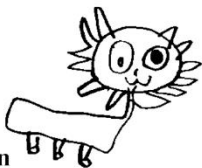

2 ½ cups of fruit

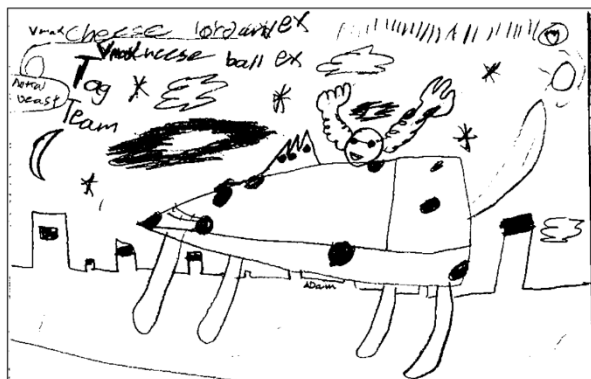
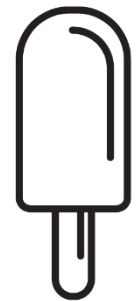
4-6 tablespoon of honey

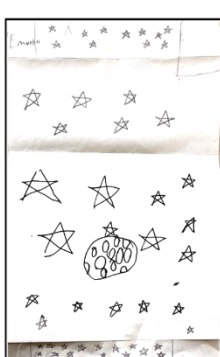
