- Sarah shared principal reports – review of operational issues such as well going dry and the fencing still being up to protect the growing grass from the sewer system replacement
- Sarah also discussed the new Code of Conduct and the requirements of following a provincial wide directive and how we all approach expected behaviors (school wide matrix) and procedures and discipline when needed.
- Sarah shared the grade 3 Provincial Assessment results in reading and writing. Our students are doing extremely well.
