#### **Regional Education Director (RED) Literacy Mandate**

- -all children by end of grade two to be at reading level.
- -all efforts to get all kids to level, so much interruption to school year
- -teachers have reading record assessments varying to grade level ie/use of books, asking questions to obtain levels/school scores
- every six weeks RED wants to see data
- -literacy and math coaches have been in three classrooms, helping and also with practices to support teachers
- -flexibility for different grade levels, different outcomes

### School trips being planned

- -very happy to plan trips
- -students have been and will be able to go to Pottery Lab, which is located in St. Catherine's Elementary
- -conscientious that students remain separate from their student body, staying in the lab only etc

#### School Art & Learning

- -being more culturally aware, value and hold interest in other cultures
- -Seven Sacred Teachings are back this year, with emphasis on not just celebrating for one month, making it a priority everyday. In morning announcements basic Mi'kmaw words and phrases are taught

- -Laila may have a connection to someone, also mentioned is the Mi'kmaw Native Friendship Centre
- -learning more about African Nova Scotians
- -Learning Centre is in place, welcoming Jenny Mathers
- -Guidance Counsellor Sarah Roberts in on Wednesdays
- -Laila is wondering if classrooms are painted, three are. Awning is next on the list. Only two painters in all of HRCE
- -mural of school logo is in it's first draft on wall inside school, grade six students will draw a representation of themselves to add to mural to leave their legacy

#### **New Business**

- -Sarah Wile, after much research, will be purchasing t-shirts from Michael's in colours of the school logo, Ardelle Giza is drawing stencils, purchasing special paint, and recruited high school students from Bayview to screen print
- -Laila is wondering if there will be a school photo with every student wearing their shirt. She is happy to take the photo. She has the equipment to do so. Sarah agrees, is hoping to have students organized in the shape of the logo, in the field, taken with a drone.
- -Proposal to change time of SAC meeting, unanimous vote to change time to 3pm.
- -SAC expecting \$5000 this school year, motion to buy math exercise books for teachers, recommended by math coaches. Unanimous vote to purchase first four books, roughly \$500 +/-
